## CLAIRE'S MENSTRUAL SPOTTING ON THE BOTTOM BED SHEET

After arriving home, Claire took a nap in her bed. Claire was having her menstrual cycle and spotted the bottom bed sheet. DNA testing of this spotting would prove that this was from Claire, which would "prove" that the story that Fisk made-up—and typed up without talking to Natasha—and forced and rehearsed Natasha to repeat was a complete "lie."

Fisk forced and rehearsed Natasha to say that she was handcuffed and spent the entire evening on Claire's bed, on top of the "bedspread"—"not" the bottom sheet—and was forced fed over 30 shots of alcohol that was forced down her throat during the entire evening. [Alcohol and handcuffs are Fisk's mind-set. Fisk is an alcoholic and handcuffs, frames and kills people, and was put in a mental illness retirement to cover-up his crimes.] And Fisk's made-up story: "was that Claire was 'never' in the bed that evening and that Natasha was handcuffed and fed alcohol on the bed the entire evening."

And even though their made-up story was that Natasha was on "top of the bedspread" (which covered the top bed sheet and the bottom bed sheet) and there was "NO" spotting on the bedspread, Prosecutor Richman waved this bottom bed sheet to the Jury and conspired with Schwab and Green to lie to the Jury and claim that this spotting was from Natasha, and that this was an important piece of evidence which proved their story to be true. This was a complete "lie." DNA testing would prove this spotting was from Claire, and therefore Natasha was never on the bed that evening, and that Claire took a nap in her bed that evening before both of them drove away at 10:30 p.m., and met the two guys.

Fisk made-up story that he forced and rehearsed Natasha to repeat, was also that Natasha spit out alcohol on the bedspread and that alcohol spilled on the bedspread. The bedspread was tested and there was no alcohol on the Bedspread and no blood spotting.

There are many facts which prove Fisk made-up story was a complete lie. Just to mention a few:

1. DNA testing would prove this menstrual spotting was from Claire and "not" Natasha as they claimed, and the story that Claire was "not" at any time in bed was a "lie," and therefore also that Natasha could "not" have been laying on top of the bedspread with Claire laying underneath the bedspread, on top of the bottom sheet, sleeping.
2. There was no alcohol spilled on the bedspread, and therefore Natasha was not forced-fed alcohol the entire evening and "spilling" it on the bedspread.
3. Fisk's made-up story that Natasha was forced-fed 30 shots of alcohol down her throat, is exposed as a "lie" because testing proved Natasha only had a 0.05 percent alcohol level, which is equivalent to only one drink at a cocktail lounge—where Claire and Natasha went to after driving off at 10:30 p.m. and met the "two guys" that Natasha stated to the Police Officer, hospital personnel and Investigator before they operated on her head.

Schwab, in conspiracy with Prosecutor Richman and Schwab's bribed defense attorney, Green, withheld the LAPD Crime Lab Report which exposed that the 4 tiny spots (on the sink, light switch, cupboard door and wall at the Catala Ave. house) were "not" blood. Schwab had Richman and Green "lie" to the Jury many hundreds of times claiming these 4 tiny spots were blood and therefore Robert Peermock was guilty. This was ridiculous, lunatic "lies." Schwab's accomplice, felon Dozier, was covered with wet-fluid blood at 4:38 a.m., and the liver temperature proved Claire was beaten to death at 4:16 a.m. And witnesses saw that Claire had "no" injuries, "no" blood on her and "no" blood in the car "after" their car was run-off the road at 3:30 a.m. At 4:38 a.m. Claire was obviously completely covered with wet-fluid blood, and so was the car's headliner, dash and seats. And before 4:16 a.m., witnesses saw that there was "no" blood on Claire and there was "no" blood in the car. Prosecutor Richman, in conspiracy with Schwab and Green, presented 5 Expert witnesses to "lie" to the Jury and claim these 4 tiny spots—found at the Catala Ave. house "24 miles away" from the crash and murder scene by Schwab's courthouse—were blood. Which was a lie. While completely ignoring and covering-up that at the murder scene "24 miles away," Schwab's felon-informant, Dozier, was covered with wet-fluid blood. At the murder scene, Fisk also stopped all the other Police Officers from searching felon Dozier's car for the murder weapon. And Fisk told felon Dozier to leave the scene although there was an outstanding warrant for his arrest, and although Dozier had over 14 arrests: for assaults on women, sabotaging cars, and judged by the courts that he could not control his violence, etc.

Appellate Judge Boren, Schwab's buddy, admitted in his opinion that the LAPD Crime Lab testing proved that the "4 tiny spots" at the Catala Ave. house were "not" blood. And Boren claimed, in his opinion, that it was OK for Prosecutor Richman, Green and his buddy Judge Schwab to "lie" to the Jury and to have their 5 Expert Witnesses "lie" to the Jury. And it was OK for them to hide the LAPD Crime Lab Report because there was menstrual cycle spotting on the bottom bed sheet. [The Autopsy Report established that Claire was having her menstrual cycle, and Claire had been drinking and came home and took a nap causing the menstrual spotting on the bottom sheet.] And Boren in his dishonest, lunatic opinion ignored that Schwab's accomplice, felon Dozier, was covered with wet-fluid blood at the crime scene, which was 24 miles away.
